



## BERRY HOWARD

August 1, 1929 - September 25, 2017

HOWARD, Berry, age 88, of Middletown, Ohio, passed away Monday, September 25, 2017 at Hospice of Butler and Warren Counties where he had been a patient for ten days. He was born August 1, 1929 in Carrollton, Alabama and moved to Ohio in the late 1950's. Berry served in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict and received an honorable discharge after almost six years of service. He was employed as a Cafeteria Supervisor at the Veteran's Administration for 38 years, retiring in 1990. Berry was a member of the Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, and a former member of the United Missionary Baptist Church where he served as a Deacon and President of the Usher Board.
