BLAIR, Charles Franklin, age 95, of Trenton, Ohio, passed away Wednesday, April 8, 2026 at his residence. He was born December 5, 1930 in Ashland, Kentucky and moved to Ohio after being discharged from the U.S. Army, where he served during WW II. He was employed at Armco Steel as a Slitter Operator for 23 years, before retiring. Charles was a member of the Moose Lodge 501 where he served as past governor, and a founding member of Moose Lodge 330. He was also a member of American Legion Post 218, where he served as an Honor Guard Member, that performs the services at the cemetery for deceased veterans. Preceding him in death was his wife, Ruby J. Blair in 2022; one son, John W. Blair; one daughter, Charlotte M. Baker; and both twin infant sons; four sisters, Betty, Shelby, Faye and Phyllis; and one brother, Curtis. He is survived by two children, Charles R. Blair (Julie M.), and Barbara F. Dougherty (Darrell); many grandchildren and great grandchildren; one sister, Marylou Vance; and numerous nieces, nephews, extended family and friends. The family is honoring his wishes to be cremated. A graveside service will be held on Tuesday, May 5, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. at the Miltonville Cemetery, 5841 Howe Road, in Miltonville, (outside of Trenton, Ohio) with Pastor Gary Agee officiating.
