ROBINSON, Rev. Cleveland, age 83, of Franklin, Ohio, went to be with his Lord on Sunday, February 8, 2015 at Spring Hill of Middletown where he had resided since September 2014. He was preceded in death by his wife, Opal Robinson and daughter Deborah (Lowell) Howard. He is survived by his daughter, Beverly (Jeffery) Collins; one brother, Rev. Gene (Rella) Robinson; three grandchildren, Doug (Amanda) Bane, Ashley (Brandon) Duley and Kameron Collins; and two great grandchildren, Taylor Duley and Madison Duley. He was born February 4, 1932 in Manchester, Kentucky to Alick and Pearlee (Davidson) Robinson. He served as a Corporal in the army during the Korean Conflict and remained on reserved status until 1960. He was ordained as a minister in the Church of God in 1966 and pastored for 25 years. He founded the Wayne Township Church of God (which is now called New Beginnings Church of God). He was an Associate Pastor of the Avondale Church of God, and the Butler Township Church of God. He was retired from Delco Products during this time. He enjoyed the outdoors, especially camping, boating and fishing.
