Rogers, Kenneth Rondall "Kenny Rogers", age 73, of Middletown, was finally reunited with his wife in heaven on Monday, June 26, 2017 at 8:27 p.m. at the Atrium Medical Center. He was born December 8, 1943 the son of Bob and Orpha (Sears) Rogers and sibling to twelve brothers and sisters. He was born and raised in Corbin, Kentucky where he spent much of his young adult life as a bootlegger. He has passed along many stories about that adventurous time in his life.
