BREWER, Larry Dale, age 70, of Middletown, Ohio, passed away Wednesday, January 28, 2026 at his residence. He was born May 13, 1955 in Middletown, and lived here all his life. During his working years he had worked his way up to a Millwright, and had been employed at Raymond Bag Company, The Champion Company and Burrows Packaging, retiring in 2015. Larry was diagnosed with kidney disease from an early age, and had been the recipient of four kidney transplants during his lifetime. His first one was when he was around 38 years old, and was given to him by his younger brother, Michael, when Michael was about 20 years old. After that he had received a kidney transplant three more times. He enjoyed spending time with his daughter. He was preceded in death by his parents, Wallace Clay and Mary M. (McGowan) Brewer; one brother, Wallace Clayton Brewer and one sister Shirley Ann Brewer. He is survived by one daughter, Izairiah Olivia Wallace; two brothers, Gary Ray Brewer (Charlene) and Michael Darrel Brewer; three sisters, Judy Marie McClain, Rosemary Adkins and Veronica Lynn Crump (Larry); and many nieces, nephews, extended family and friends. 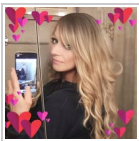
