



## LETHA C. JORDAN

September 9, 1924 - June 29, 2016

JORDAN, Letha C., age 91, of Middletown, Ohio, passed away Wednesday, June 29, 2016 at University Hospital of Cincinnati, where she had been a patient for five days. She was born September 9, 1924, in Lakeland, Florida, she married and moved to Ohio in 1945. In her early years she worked for her father, who was a master baker, in many different bakeries in Florida. She was a beloved wife and mother. Letha was a good friend and confidant. She was often sought after for help and advice on personal or practical problems. She never had a bad word to say about anyone. Letha was active for 70 years in the Elk's #257 Socialites and served on the Ways and Means Committee. She decorated the lodge for all events and holidays for 30 years. She organized and did the baking for all the lodge Bake Sales, and her own Bake Sales at many of the lodge dinners.
