OBITUARY FOR MERVIN RUSSELL

RUSSELL, Mervin, age 72, of Middletown, Ohio, passed away suddenly on Saturday, April 16, 2016 at Miami Valley Hospital in Dayton, where he had been a patient for two days. He was born July 4, 1943 in Haddix, Kentucky and moved to Ohio when he was seventeen years old. He served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War. Mervin was employed as a machinist, and also in the Skid Shop at Middletown Paper Board Company for 38 years, retiring in 2006. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter Day Saints, and a member of Moose Lodge #501. Preceding him in death were his parents, Herman and Lizzie Smith Russell; his wife, Judy Russell in 2015; two brothers, Virgil and Charles; and one sister Jewell Grider. He is survived by two daughters, Lara Russell Scherman and Katherine Russell; one granddaughter, Kalie Smith; one sister, Jessie (Bobby) Gross; one brother, Nathan (Sue) Russell; several nieces, nephews, extended family and friends.
