REID, Nicholas George "Nick", of Trenton, Ohio, passed away early in the morning of Saturday, September 14, 2024 at the age of 84. He leaves behind one daughter, Tracey (William) Hicks; one son, Todd Reid; five grandchildren; as well as many extended family in Owingsville, Kentucky and many co-workers and friends in Ohio.
