



PAMELA RENEE MAINES

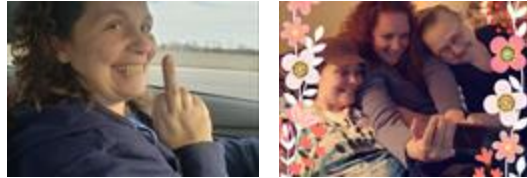
October 19, 1971 - July 31, 2023
