BELL, Robert W., age 77, of Franklin, Ohio, passed away Thursday, May 22, 2014 at Carlisle Manor Health Care Center, where he had been a patient for four months. Bob was born July 19, 1936 in Middletown and lived in this area all his life. He graduated from Middletown High School in the Class of '54, and was a band member during his school years. He served in the U. S. Marine Corps, and played clarinet in the U.S. Marine Marching Band. He was employed at AK Steel in the Coil Paint Department, retiring in 1993. He also had worked as a clerk at Dason's Hardware, and was a Van Driver for the Senior Citizens Deardoff Center.
