O'BRIEN, Vivian (nee McIntosh) suddenly and unexpectedly passed away on June 29, 2020 at the age of 72. Vivian was born 2 months premature in her family home in Bulan, Ky on Easter Sunday March 28, 1948 and weighed just under 3 pounds. At a young age, her family moved to Middletown, Ohio where she lived most of her life. She graduated from Middletown High School Class of 1966 Vivian worked for Monsanto's Mound Laboratories (later EG&G) located in Miamisburg, Ohio retiring 1993. She was a member of the Women of the Moose #184. Vivian enjoyed collecting antiques and was an avid animal lover. She was preceded in death by her parents, Henry Clay and Virginia (Collins) McIntosh; and two brothers, Joey Dale McIntosh and Glenn McIntosh. 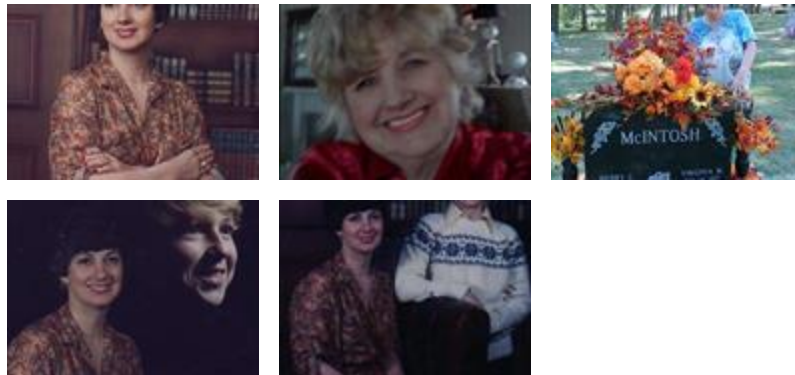
