BLACK, JR., William W., age 76, of Monroe, Ohio, passed away Friday, July 15, 2016 at Woodglen's Alzheimer Community in Dayton, Ohio where he had been a patient for two years. He was born February 9, 1940 in Middletown and lived in this area all his life. He graduated from Middletown High School in 1958, and was employed as a machinist at AK Steel for 41 years, retiring in 2000.
